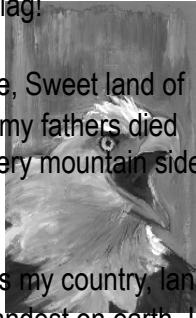


Star Spangled Banner Oh, say can you see,
